# NUHW members pay much less for health care

Members of UC unions pay up to \$4,000 a year for the same coverage we get for free.

NUHW members also enjoy significantly lower costs for a variety of PPO programs.

## NUHW members enjoy a FREE Kaiser plan

We have access to the Kaiser HMO for ourselves and our dependents, at no cost to us. The plan is free for both part-time and full-time workers, regardless of salary. Meanwhile, members of UC unions pay **up to \$4,000 a year** for their Kaiser coverage.

## NUHW members' PPO premiums are much lower

NUHW members who prefer to receive care through a PPO have a variety of coverage options and pay just 15 percent of the premium per month, regardless of which plan they choose. By contrast, a member of a UC union who chooses the Anthem PPO for their family will pay more than \$900 a month in premiums — that's more than \$10,000 per year.

#### NUHW members face no cost increases

Our NUHW contract protects us from increases to our healthcare premiums, whereas members of the UC unions can see their costs **increase every year**.

#### The PPO Plans

Members of UC unions who choose a PPO plan pay much more for coverage, up to more than \$900\* per month. NUHW members pay just 15% of the monthly premium, and costs cannot be increased during the life of the contract.

\*A UC union member earning more than \$71,000 would pay \$901 monthly for family coverage with the UC Care Anthem PPO — that's \$10,818 per year.
