NUHW Let's Stay United!

Our wages are better than those of UC workers

For the vast majority of NUHW workers, our wages are higher than those of our UC union counterparts.

There are a small minority of classifications whose wages are higher at UCSF.

In either case, after factoring in the cost of UC union benefits, NUHW members' overall take-home pay is much higher.

NUHW members' wages are higher

The average **starting wage** of NUHW members is \$3.67 higher than the average starting wage of workers in the three UC unions. The average **maximum wage** of NUHW members is \$2.53 higher.

NUHW members' average take-home pay is much higher

Members in the UC unions pay \$2,000 to \$4,200 a year for their healthcare plan and have a mandatory 9 percent employee retirement contribution, making their take-home pay far lower than that of NUHW members.

NUHW members move up the wage scale faster

It takes UC union members almost **5.5 years** longer to reach the maximum wage.
